1. Listening	<i>Listens first to understand, not just to respond. James 1:19</i>
2. Empathizing	<i>Seeks to understand others with compassion and care. Romans 12:15</i>
3. Acting Intentionally	<i>Leads with awareness and thoughtful action. Proverbs 16:3</i>
4. Dedicating Time to Others	<i>Builds relationships by being present and available. 1 Thessalonians 2:8</i>
5. Empowering Others	<i>Develops people and creates space for them to grow. Ephesians 4:11–12</i>
6. Removing Obstacles	<i>Identifies and removes barriers that hold others back. Isaiah 58:6</i>
7. Serving Others	<i>Leads as a steward, focused on the good of others. Mark 10:45</i>
8. Humble Help	<i>Influences through humility, not control. Philippians 2:3–4</i>
9. Acting with Integrity	<i>Acts with honesty and consistency in all things. Proverbs 11:3</i>
10. Persevering	<i>Remains steady and encourages others through challenges. Galatians 6:9</i>
